Aruba - Destination Passport

Entry and Transit restrictions apply:

Visitors must hold return/onward tickets.

The following regulations apply to children/minors:

Unaccompanied minors, who are 17 years of age or younger, must hold a letter of consent from the parent/guardian.

Aruba - Destination Visa

Visa required.

The following are exempt from holding a visa:

Passengers with a valid "D" visa issued by a Schengen Member State .

Passengers with a multiple-entry "C" visa issued by a Schengen Member State and valid for the period of intended stay. They are exempt for a maximum stay of 90 days.

Nationals of Jamaica with a multiple-entry visa issued by Canada, Ireland, USA or the United Kingdom and valid for the period of intended stay. They are exempt for a maximum stay of 90 days.

Additional information:

Visitors are required to hold proof of sufficient funds to cover their stay, proof of hotel accommodation and documents required for their next destination

Holders of a visa issued by Canada, USA or a Schengen Member State are granted a max. stay of 90 days within 1 calendar year in the Kingdom of the Netherlands in the Caribbean (Aruba, Curacao, Bonaire, St. Eustasius and Saba, St. Maarten).
